

Help Unlock the Mystery of Cancer

Austin Skiers and Boarders along with Central Texas residents have an unprecedented opportunity to play an active role in cancer research. Enrollment for the American Cancer Society's third Cancer Prevention Study will be taking place at the American Cancer Society offices in Austin, **March 1-5**. Individuals between the ages of 30 and 65 who have never been diagnosed with cancer and are willing to make a long-term commitment to the study are encouraged to sign up. You will be asked to complete a health related survey, have measurements taken and give a small blood sample. Every 2-3 years you will be contacted to complete a follow up survey on your health and activities. If you aren't eligible to participate, you can still make a difference by volunteering for a 4-hour shift at an enrollment site or by telling everyone you know about the Cancer Prevention Study-3.

I enrolled because cancer is prevalent in my family and I want future generations of family members to have a better chance of being cancer free. It took about an hour for me to enroll and the follow up survey took about 10 minutes to complete. It was easy!

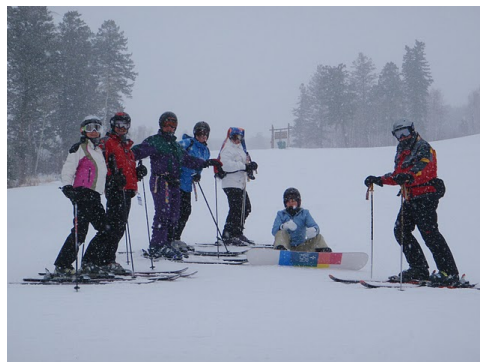
