The Criss Cole Rehabilitation Center is seeking donations of ski goggles for use in their adaptive sports program. Criss Cole is a residential training center for blind adults, located here in Austin. The center teaches cane travelling skills, technology, Braille, and much more. Your donation will help to further develop their adaptive sports programs. Donated goggles may be used, scratched, cracked, etc. (The center plans to "black out" the visor with tape so that athletes participate on an equal footing). The club will collect donated goggles at the **April & May general membership meetings**.
