

As you look at the trip line-up please also read the <u>Trip Policies AND Trip Cancellation Policies</u>. The <u>cancellation policies are not necessarily the same for each trip</u> - so please read the one applicable to the trip you are interested in.

If you purchased an **EPIC PASS** for the 2020/21 ski season you know reservations are required. An email from EPIC PASS was sent out today (Nov. 2) explaining their system, which is divided into two "seasons." They have an "Early Season" (Nov. 6 - Dec. 7) and a "Core Season" (Dec. 8 - April 4). They have an online video explanation and an FAQ. Click on <u>EPIC PASS</u> for further information.

Many of us are experienced travelers and probably know what documents we need to take whether it's an overseas trip or domestic. Here is a link that outlines the most <u>important travel documents</u> we'll need. Please note that as of <u>October 2021</u> **ALL** domestic are **required** to have a **Real ID**. You can still use your passport or an approved TSA ID. See <u>Department of Homeland Security</u> (DHS) for further details. The Austin Skiers do not endorse the particular website for their products, but only as a source of useful information.

Warren Miller Entertainment announced on September 17 it would debut the company's 71st film called "Future Retro" as a digital event. There are three (3) dates for the "coming to your living room" virtual tour, which are organized by regions of the North America. Beginning with the East Coast on November 7, followed by Mountain/Central on November 14 and the finale will be on the West Coast on November 21.
